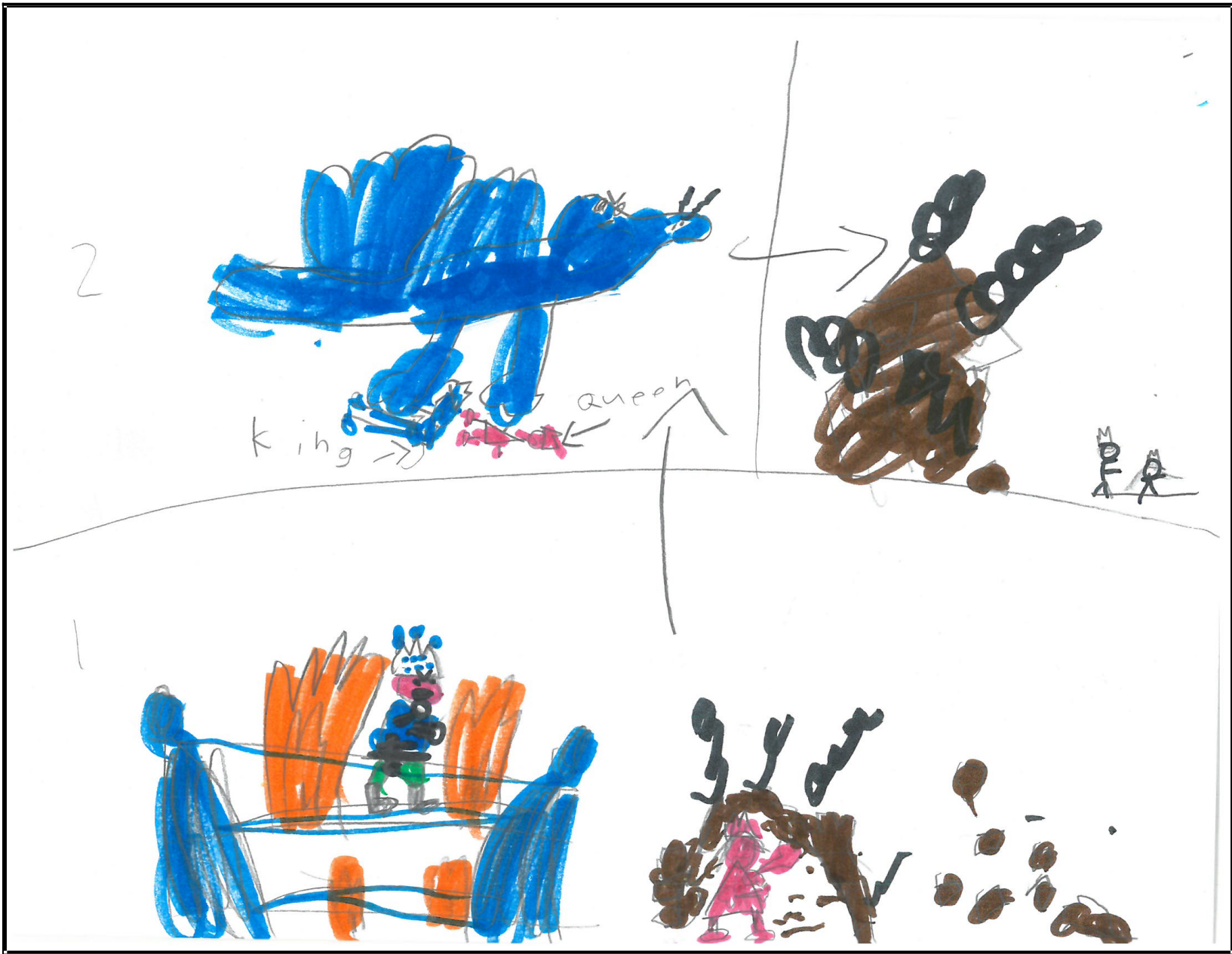

Ash and Isabelle were with their parents in the castle when they heard a roar.

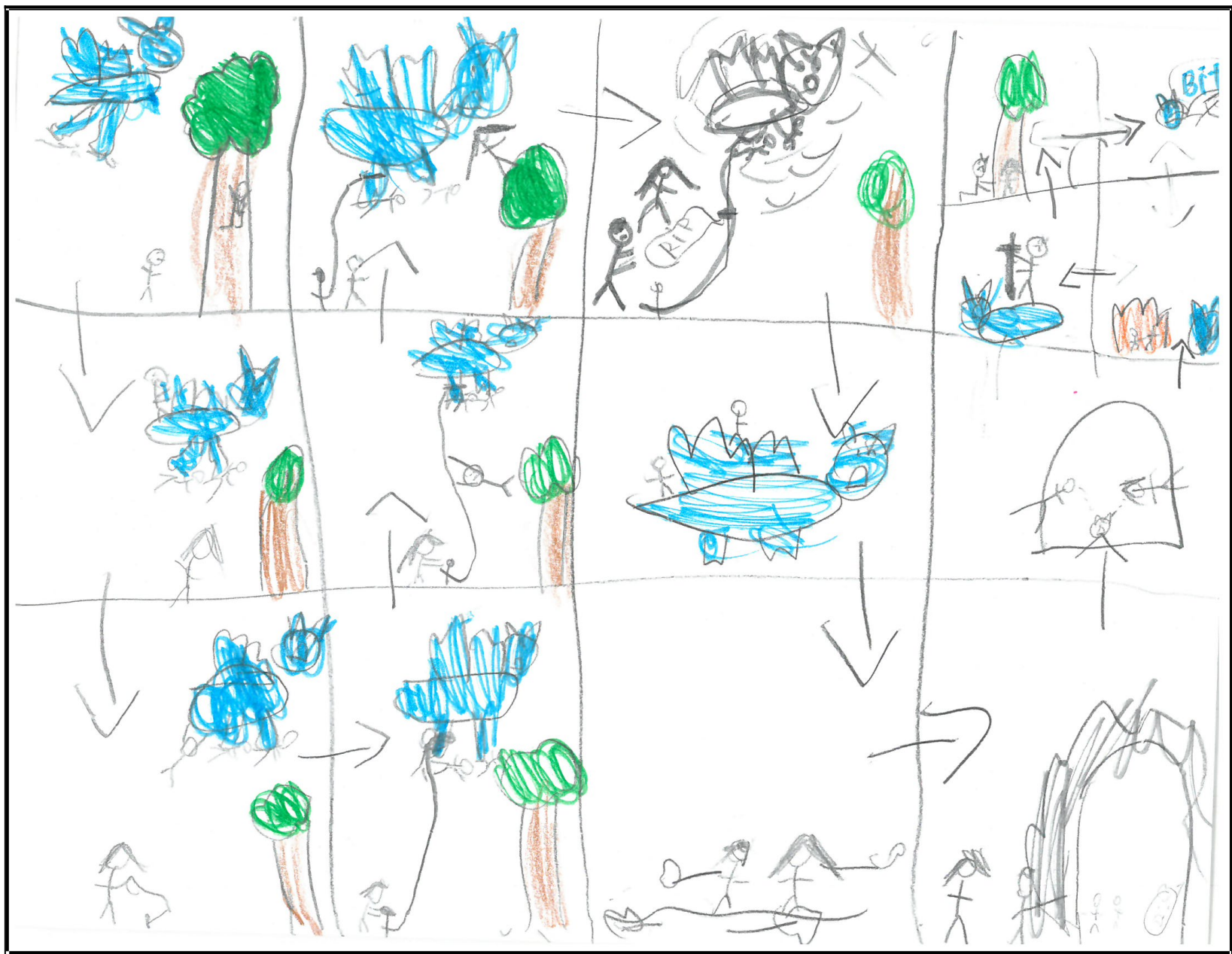
Ash and Isabelle are the Prince and Princess of the castle, their parents are the King and Queen. Ash loves climbing and Isabelle is really good at taming animals.

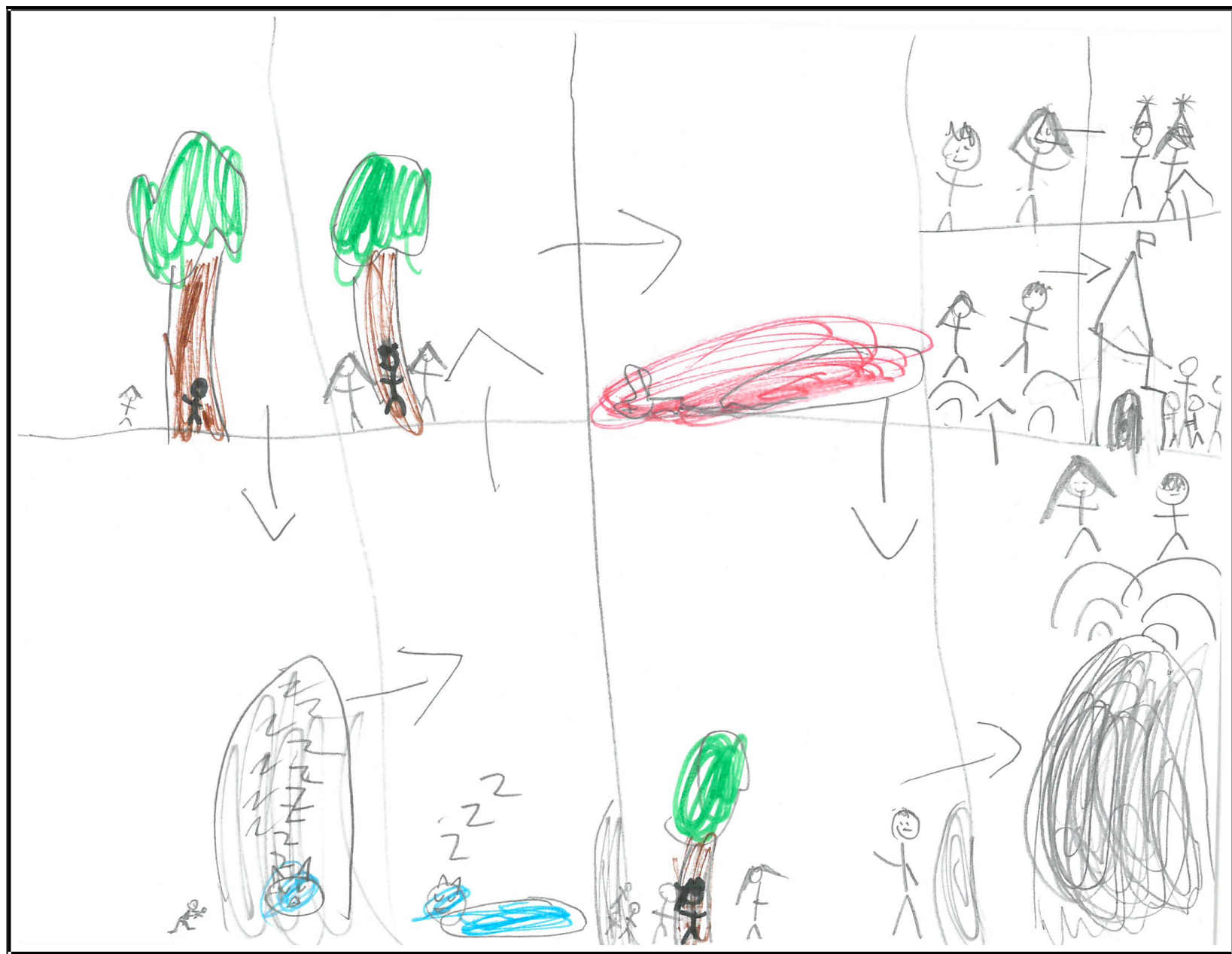
